Psychologist

<u>Overview:</u> Work with individuals, groups, and families affected by emotional, mental, behavioral, social, and adjustment issues, to help them cope with the challenges in their lives

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Conduct psychological and psycho-educational evaluations
- Provide timely and appropriate assessment, interpretation and diagnosis of mental, social and emotional disorders
- Collect relevant supplementary documentation and information to assist in determining treatment plans and interventions
- Refer clients for supplementary tests as indicated, including psychiatric, neurological, and medical tests to assist in determining diagnosis and treatment plans
- Develop and plan individualized treatment plans for the presenting problems, in consultation with other professionals as appropriate
- Implement treatment interventions including individual, couples, group, and family psychotherapy, behavior modification techniques, coping strategies; apply specialized techniques as appropriate
- Effectively provide psycho-education, support, and resources to clients and family members
- Research and refer clients and family members to other services where necessary (e.g., employment services, psychiatric rehabilitation services, medication management)
- Ensure the treatment plan is being adhered to
- Monitor and evaluate progress towards treatment goals and adjust treatment plans as necessary
- Provide crisis intervention as necessary
- Maintain current, accurate and complete electronic clinical records
- Prepare required reports and documentation in a timely fashion
- Meet all continuing education requirements
- Work collaboratively with families and professionals

- Participate in multi-disciplinary team meetings
- Comply with organizational, state and federal regulations and guideline
